Covert Gestures: Crypto-Islamic Literature as Cultural Practice in Early Modern Spain



Forcibly expelled from Spain in the early seventeenth century, the substantial Muslim community known as the moriscos left out them a hidden yet incredibly rich corpus of manuscripts. Copied out in Arabic script and concealed in walls, false floors, and remote control caves, these little-known texts now give modern visitors an absorbing check out the cultural life of the moriscos during the hundred years between their forced conversion to Christianity and their eventual expulsion. Covert Gestures reveals the way the traditional Islamic narratives of the moriscos both formed and encoded a wide range of covert interpersonal activity characterized by a profound and persistent nervous about period and temporality. In its interdisciplinary strategy, Vincent Barletta's function is nothing significantly less than a rewriting of the cultural background of Muslim Spain, as well as a replotting into the future course of medieval and early modern literary studies. Utilizing a unique mixture of literary evaluation, linguistic anthropology, and phenomenological philosophy, Barletta explores the narratives as testimonials of past human encounters and discovers in them proof community resistance.
