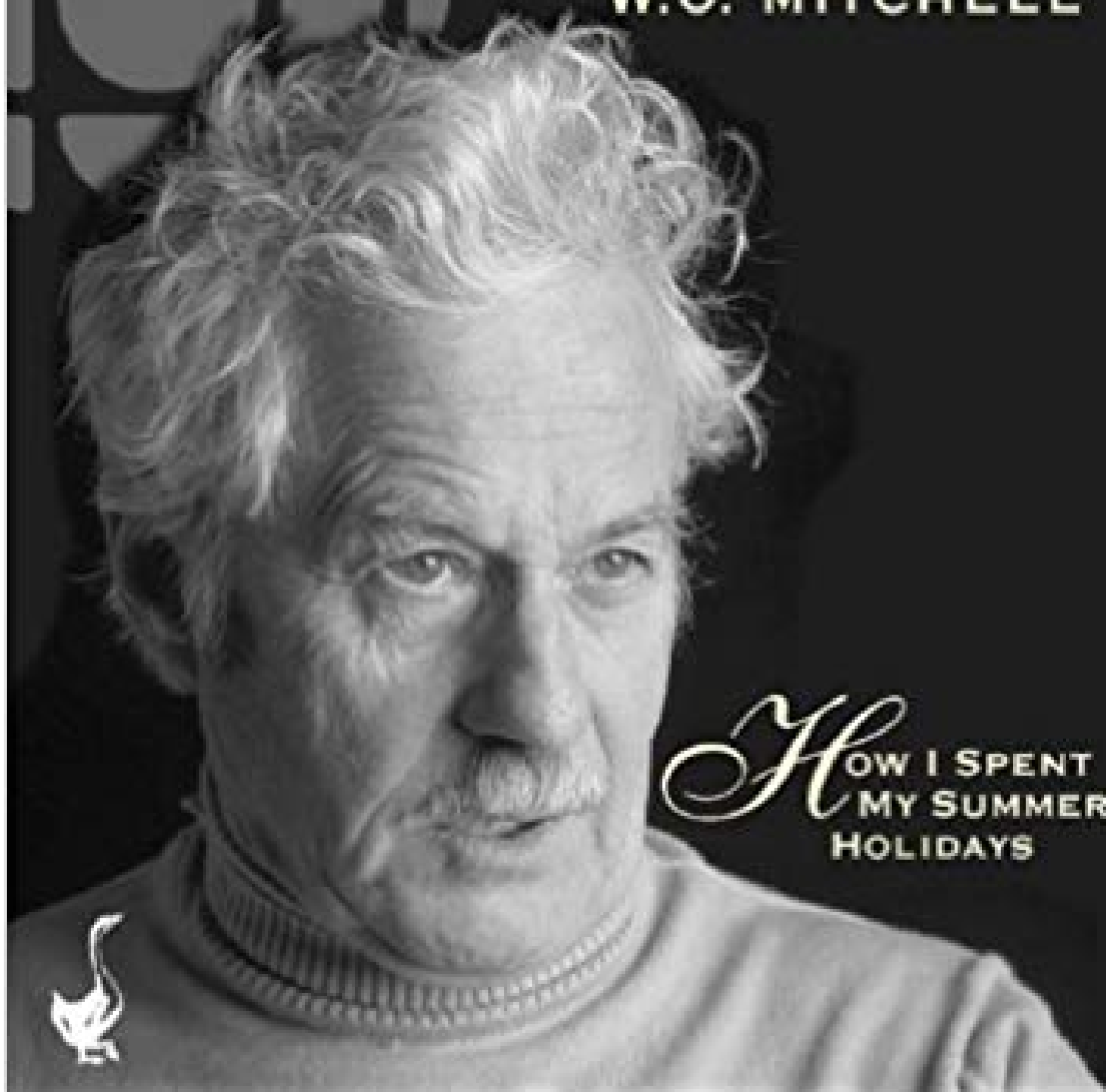

The twelve-year-old young man is normally Hugh, and in small-town Saskatchewan it's the hot summer months of 1924."
