This book presents findings from a survey of sixteen functional health units at four different degrees of local governments in Uganda. The survey data offer systematic evidence on how health administration structures of decentralization are working at the amount of local governments to provide health services. Its health policy in addition has been guided by the Bamako Initiative to encourage and maintain community participation in wellness services. Uganda is one of the few countries in the developing globe to systematically decentralize the delivery of fundamental health solutions to locally elected regional governments. The phenomenon could possibly be reduced through meaningful community participation and the belief was that the decentralized program of health service management would offer an environment for such participation. The writer carried out the analysis basing on the fact that most deaths in Uganda are because of conditions that could in any other case be preventable. Thus attention should be attracted to procedures that involve community participation but with special focus on vulnerable groups, especially the rural poor, ladies, and children.
