Kathleen Mannington Caffyn (nee Hunt) (1852- 1926) was an Irish-Australian novelist. She qualified as a nurse and married a medical practitioner, and went with him to Sydney in 1880. Amongst her other functions certainly are a Comedy in Spasms (1895), A Quaker Grandmother (1896), Anne Manleverer (1899) and Dorinda and Her Daughter (1910). Mrs. Caffyn contributed a tale of some sixty pages to Cooe: Tales of Australian Life by Australian Ladies (1891), and wrote a novel A Yellow Aster, which was released in London in 1894 under the pseudonym of "Iota" It had an immediate achievement and was quickly followed by Children of Circumstance (1894), and by some 15 other volumes in the twenty years that followed.. She was a founder of the District Nursing Society in Victoria and offered on its committee for around two years.
