Over the past 2 decades there has been a marked change in global age demographics, with the amount of over-60s increasing by 82% and the number of centenarians by 715%. Over 170 chapters are broken up into 16 key sections, covering topics ranging from policy and key concepts to infection, cancers, palliative medication, and healthy ageing.
