It's very clear that Mr. Gagliardi is extremely passionate about all things Sun Tzu. Through numerous repackaged books marketed both here at Amazon and through the "Science of Strategy Institute" he setup to sell you Sunlight Tzu themed board video games and movies, he has certainly made a virtual cottage industry of Sunzi-phenalia. In addition, he offers personalized training packages for up to \$1,500 to amp up your capability to unleash the power

of Sun Tzu's program of total and complete victory in all competitive endeavors you face, whether in the boardroom or the bedroom. There are too many professionally performed Sun Tzu translations available by qualified people (Ames, Griffith, Sawyer, Ivanhoe, Mair, Minford) to justify paying out the same amount of money for Mr. Gagliardi at his most elementary task: competently translating Sun Tzu's original text message, *The Art of War*? Still very interesting. Gagliardi: Competent translator of classical Chinese or "common mountain" snake-oil salesman? In lieu of a laundry list I will give you just a one line example where Mr. Family members, bosses, neighbors, workers and the list goes on. I preserve a database of 30 translations of *The Art of Battle* in English that I use to compare various initiatives, and included the screenshot of the relevant verse so you can evaluate it to how others have approached the text. I noticed it has more to offer. To display how this is often remedied, Sun Tzu brings up the example of how a certain snake can provide a very important lesson for his soldiers.
