I hope No Sanctuary gets the eye and acclaim it deserves. It was amazing how well Lane manages to create the context in a balanced way also to explore how this was truly a group effort that worked well against traditional models of top-down transformation. An analysis like this can be fraught with potential pitfalls -- missing important individuals or events, providing a version of events that differs from somebody else's version, etc. As a higher school instructor deeply involved in these efforts, I thought Lane really captured how this modification happened from the grassroots level up, proposing a model that focuses on how building human relationships locally can transform the climate.
