Today, the Batak put on traditional jewelry only for celebrations like wedding ceremonies, and these stunning functions are rapidly disappearing, getting melted down or sold. Men, women, small children, and also babies were once adorned with gold, silver, brass, bronze, or the gold-and-copper alloy known as suasa. Batak jewelry is definitely characterized by a wide variety of components and forms, and offers many features: Jewels can be status symbols, badges of rank, attributes of membership into a certain age group, amulets and talismans, or just ornaments. The first book to examine the rich jewelry traditions of the Batak people in Indonesia is a striking tribute to a vanishing way of life. The nearly 300 valuable works shown here are artifacts of a once-flourishing jewelry tradition.
