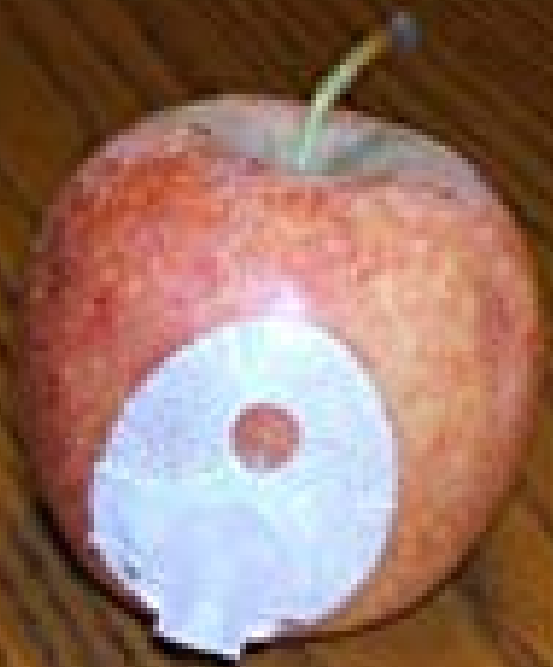


Type 1 Diabetes for People Who Don't Have It
